OnDemand Medication-Assisted Treatment

Bright Heart Health is providing telehealth care across Ohio for substance use disorder services. Telehealth removes barriers that may impact an offenders ability to receive or continue treatment - barriers such as work schedule, transportation, disability or mobility issues, child or elder care, appointment availability and now the recent growing **COVID-19** outbreak.

As all areas are concerned with this outbreak, these services are available to your offenders 24/7. Telehealth is available to individuals at home or wherever they can get cell or wifi access, and helps limit an individuals exposure or spread of the virus.

There is **no cost** to your court to utilize our services.

- Our program would give offenders who have any **transportation** issues an opportunity to receive treatment.
- Our program would give offenders who have any **disability** issues an opportunity to receive treatment.
- Telehealth allows those with schedule **constraints due to distance, work, school or children** the ability to receive treatment.
- Our services do not need to be offered exclusively but rather in addition to any local providers - we can help support.
- Offenders that may have been excluded from the docket for not meeting requirements again such as transport, schedule or otherwise could now be included.
- Services are **free** for the Court & Offenders.
- Bright Heart Health is **available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**

In addition:

- Bright Heart Health can assess individuals and provide a **recommendation** to the court within 24 Hours of receiving the referral.
- **Progress Reports** will be completed weekly.
- **Drug Screens** once per week. If there are any questions surrounding the results of a screening the patient will be sent to their nearest Lab for screening. We can also use screens completed by the court.
- **Program Compliance*** will be measured through some of the following factors: Attendance, Drug Screens, and Medication (is the patient taking their medication as prescribed). *The court will be notified if there is any non-compliance.
- **Weekly Group Therapy**
- **Individual Therapy**
- **Private & Confidential:** Patients can join from Home or other private locations with use of a phone, tablet or computer.
- **Our Program is supported and funded in part by the Ohio Mental Health and Addiction Services (OHMAS).**
