{¶1} THE COURT FINDS THAT:

{¶2} 1) On September 23, 2002, a judge of the Court of Claims issued an entry (Jr. Vol. 719, Pg. 193) transferring this case to the administrative docket;

{¶3} 2) On October 11, 2002, a judge of the Court of Claims issued an entry (Jr. Vol. 721, Pg. 195) denying plaintiff's motions for relief under Civ. R. 60(B)(1) or 60(B)(5) and for an interpreter. The judge reaffirmed that the case remains on the administrative docket;

{¶4} 3) On October 10, 2002, plaintiff filed a motion for discovery pursuant to C.C.R. 6(E);

{¶5} 4) On October 17, 2002, plaintiff filed a "motion to communicate in what appears to be obstructing justice-R.C. §2921.32(A) and (5), failure to report a crime-R.C. §2921.22(A),

and, misprison of felony-Title 18 §4";

{¶6} 5) On October 21, 2002, plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal.

{¶7} IT IS ORDERED THAT:

{¶8} 1) Plaintiff's notice is considered a motion for voluntary dismissal and is GRANTED;

{¶9} 2) Plaintiff's case is DISMISSED without prejudice;

{¶10} 3) All pending motions are MOOT;

{¶11} 4) Court costs are assessed against plaintiff.
