{¶1} THE COURT FINDS THAT:

{¶2} 1) On September 16, 2002, plaintiff, Frank Shipman, filed a complaint but failed to provide a mailing address for defendant. Plaintiff also failed to submit the filing fee or an affidavit of indigency with the complaint;

{¶3} 2) On September 16, 2002, this court issued a notice that filing fee was not paid. The notice stated in pertinent part: "Your case may be dismissed unless you pay the required filing fee or file an affidavit of indigency prior to October 7, 2002.";

{¶4} 3) On September 17, 2002, this court issued a return of complaint form/direction to complete form notice. The notice required plaintiff to file a complaint form providing a complete mailing address for defendant. The notice, in pertinent part, stated: "The completed complaint must be filed in this court before October 15, 2002. If the completed complaint is not returned to this office before the above date, your complaint will be dismissed.";

{¶5} 4) A check of the docket reveals plaintiff has neither

submitted the filing fee or an affidavit of indigency nor submitted the completed form complaint.

{¶6} IT IS ORDERED THAT:

{¶7} 1) Plaintiff's case is DISMISSED without prejudice;

{¶8} 2) The court shall absorb the court costs of this case.
