The Judges of the Columbiana County Municipal Court make the following Findings of Fact:

1. On March 17, 2020, the Columbiana County Municipal Court Ordered a Temporary Order in Response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Public Health Crisis (20-MISC-48); and
2. On May 17 2021 Ohio Director of Health, Stephanie McCloud issued a Second Amended Order for Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-Congregating in response to Ohio Governor Mike DeWine's statement made on May 14, 2021 regarding Ohio's response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Based upon these Findings of Fact, the Judges signing below, on behalf of Columbiana County Municipal Court have developed a continuum of flexible responses to help transition out of the public health emergency. The continuum of responses are necessary and consistent with and are intended to protect the public health, to maintain essential court functions, and to continue to protect the rights of all individuals subject to the authority of the Court.


THEREFORE, EFFECTIVE MAY 19, 2021, and until further Order:

1. The Order of the Court dated 20-MISC-48 is vacated.
2. Individuals and employees accessing the Court who have not been vaccinated are required to wear a mask or facial covering until further Order.
3. Individuals and employees accessing the Court who have been fully vaccinated (fully vaccinated refers to a person who is greater than 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series or greater than 2 weeks following receipt of one dose in a single-dose vaccine, per the CDC) are not required to wear a mask or facial covering.

4. The Court will continue to implement social distancing in the lobby and Courtroom.
5. The Court will continue to take electronic temperatures of those individuals entering the front door of the building and ask any follow-up health questions if needed.
