JUDGMENT ENTRY

IN RE: CONTINUING TEMPORARY ORDER IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19
(CORONAVIRUS) PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS: RESTORATION PHASE

The Coshocton County Common Pleas Court, Juvenile and Probate Divisions, makes the following additional orders effective **June 3, 2021**, and supplementing the Temporary Orders In Response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Public Health Crisis, filed March 26, 2020, April 13, 2020, and May 11, 2020.

Whereas effective May 11, 2020, an order was issued in compliance with the Ohio Public Health Advisory System mandating the wearing of mask and detailing the Court operations for the Coshocton County Probate and Juvenile Court, located at 426 Main Street, Coshocton Ohio by all persons not otherwise exempted; and

Whereas pursuant to Ohio Department of Health (ODH) Orders issued May 17, 2021, in accordance with the guidance issued by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention on May 13, 2021, all fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask under safe conditions;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all fully vaccinated people as defined in the May 17, 2021 ODH Director's Order may enter the Courthouse without facial covering effective June 3, 2021, upon confirmation & authorization of such vaccine status and the absence of any unsafe conditions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all individuals who are not fully vaccinated are required to wear a facial covering unless otherwise exempted. The exceptions include children under the age of ten (10) and individuals with medical conditions or disabilities that prevents wearing facial coverings.

The Coshocton County Probate and Juvenile Court shall have full authority to establish procedures and protocols within the confines of their individual departmental offices, even if such procedures may be more restrictive than this order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
