ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This matter came on for consideration this 15th day of June, 2021 to supersede the Court's prior Administrative Order of March 26, 2021 journalized at Vol. 142, Pg. 331.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The Court remains "Open with Restrictions."
2. In-person hearings remain limited to essential matters as determined by the presiding jurist in keeping with previous guidance from the Supreme Court of Ohio and provided that appropriate safety measures remain in place.
3. The Court shall continue to attempt to minimize the social interaction of parties, attorneys, witnesses, law enforcement personnel, and judicial personnel by conducting proceedings, to the extent practicable, by remote video, telephonic, or other available technological means.
4. Beginning Wednesday, June 16, 2021, all Court employees (except as provided in paragraph five herein) who have provided proof of vaccination against COVID-19 to the Human Resources Department and received a sticker on their ID badge demonstrating same are no longer required to wear a mask in the courthouse unless when otherwise directed to do so by a supervisor.
5. Any Court employee not vaccinated, or who chooses not to provide proof of vaccination, shall continue to wear a mask. All Court employees working in the Detention Center and in Pre-Trial Monitoring shall continue to wear masks regardless of vaccination status.
6. All members of the public shall be required to wear a mask in the courthouse regardless of vaccination status.
7. The Court's prior Administrative Order of March 20, 2020 journalized at Vol. 142, Pg. 291 restricting Detention Center admissions to youth whose charge(s) constitute a felony if committed by an adult is hereby vacated in its entirety.
8. All other orders in the June 25, 2020 Administrative Order journalized at Vol. 142, Pg. 306 and the June 12, 2020 Administrative Order journalized at Vol. 142, Pg. 305 that have not been specifically modified herein remain in full force and effect.

9. This Order shall be served on the Supreme Court of Ohio, Ohio Judicial Conference, Cuyahoga County Clerk of Courts, Cleveland Metropolitan Bar Association, Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office, Cuyahoga County Public Defender's Office, Cuyahoga County Criminal Defense Lawyer's Association, Cuyahoga County Sheriff, Cuyahoga County Board of Health, Cuyahoga County Executive, Cuyahoga County Council, the website of this Court, and distributed to the media.
