## JOURNAL ENTRY

On March 9, 2020, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine issued Executive Order 2020-01D declaring a "State of Emergency" in response to the growing COVID-19 public health emergency.

In consideration of the Executive Order, the Court orders as follows:

- 1. The First District Court of Appeals is continuing to conduct business.
- 2. Effective March 18, 2020, and continuing through April 17, 2020, all oral arguments previously scheduled are converted to non-oral submissions, and the Judges will decide cases on briefs only. There will be no oral argument unless leave is granted. If such leave is granted, the rescheduled date for oral argument will be determined by further order of the Court.
- 3. The Court will continue to schedule the non-oral submission of cases beginning April 20, 2020, and continuing until further notice. The Judges will decide the cases on the briefs only. There will be no oral argument unless leave is granted. If leave is granted, a date for oral argument will be determined by future court order.
