
**ORDER GRANTING BLANKET  
EXTENSIONS**

As a result of the national, state and county declaration of a public health emergency regarding the coronavirus ("COVID-19") outbreak and worldwide pandemic, and further as a result of the current "stay at home" order across the State of Ohio, the Court believes that further relief is warranted for practitioners and pro se filers with cases pending before this Court. Therefore, the Court orders as follows:

1. Filing Deadlines. The Court grants an automatic 60 day extension of the due date of all filings that are now due, or that become due between the date of this Order and May 31, 2020. This extension applies to all cases of every type now pending in this Court. The 60 day extension runs from the actual date of the filing deadline then in effect before the granting of this extension. It is not necessary to file any application to obtain this extension.
2. Trials and Contested Hearings. The Court continues all trials and contested hearings currently scheduled before this Court for an additional 60 days beyond their currently scheduled date. It is not necessary to file any motion for a continuance.
3. Scheduling Orders. The Court extends the deadlines of all events in Scheduling Orders that are now in effect for an additional 60 days. It is not necessary to file any motion for a continuance or extension of these dates.
4. Rescheduling. After the public health crisis is lifted and the Court resumes its normal operations, the Court will schedule an Interim Pretrial Conference on each pending trial or contested matter to make any scheduling adjustments that may be necessary.

To the extent that this Order is in conflict with anything in the Court's March 16 Emergency Order Regarding Public Health Emergency, this Order takes priority and supersedes the March 16 Order.

It is so ordered.
