
Parenting Time during COVID-19


Public Health Crisis

In furtherance of the Court's recent orders during the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis, the Court Orders, effective immediately that:

- With respect to parenting time or companionship and visitation issues and the state ordered school closures, parents, legal custodians, or others who have shared parenting plans, joint custody, custody, or companionship and visitation orders should continue to follow those orders to the best of their abilities and in the spirit intended by the Court.
- Any on-line or home-based schooling directed to children by their school(s) must be completed in a timely fashion in all parties' homes.
- Parties should comply with the orders in their case relative to holiday and spring break schedules, pursuant to the schedules designated by their child(ren)'s school(s) at the beginning of the school year, regardless of recent changes. Parties should follow the regular parenting, shared parenting, joint custody, custody, or companionship and visitation schedule set forth in the orders in their case during all other times, unless their orders specifically address school closures.
- Parties should also communicate about the location, health, and welfare of the children daily and should discuss travel plans and arrangements as required by their orders in their case.

These Orders shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
