DURING A PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS August 27, 2021

Due to the rapid increase in the number of COVID-19 cases, the increasing spread of the Delta variant in the region, and recent research showing that vaccinated individuals can spread the disease if they become infected, the Judges have determined that an additional Administrative Order is necessary to implement measures and precautions that ensure the safety of our staff and the public, and protect the rights of all individuals subject to the authority of the Court, THEREFORE:

All Jury Trials for criminal, traffic, civil, and eviction cases, scheduled for the Dayton Municipal Court during the month of September, shall be Continued and all speedy trial time statutes of limitation and time requirements shall be tolled by the Judges until a future date after September 30, 2021.

This Order shall be provided to the Supreme Court of Ohio, Ohio Judicial Conference, Dayton Municipal Court Clerk of Court, Dayton Bar Association, City of Dayton Prosecutor, Montgomery County Prosecutor, Montgomery County Public Defender, and Montgomery County Sheriff and shall be available through the website of this Court.

Further Orders may be made as deemed necessary by the Court.
