The Judges of the General Division of the Common Pleas Court of Sandusky, County, Ohio, makes the following Findings of Fact and Administrative Order:

- 1. On March 9, 2020, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine issued Executive Order 2020-01D "Declaring a State of Emergency" in response to the growing COVID-19 public health crisis.
- 2. On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization officially declared COVID-19 to be a global "pandemic" requiring "urgent and aggressive action" to control the spread of the virus.

Based upon these findings of fact, the General Division of the Court of Common Pleas will develop a continuum of flexible responses in case the public health crisis escalates or increases in size and scope. The continuum of responses is intended to protect public health, to maintain essential court functions, and to continue to protect the rights of all individuals subject to the authority of the courts.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- All foreclosure cases are hereby stayed for a period of 45 days. All Sheriff's sales are suspended for 45 days. The Sheriff is ordered to return the order of sale without execution in all Sheriff's sales cases from March 30, 2020 until April 15, 2020. All private selling officer sales are suspended as well and the private selling officer shall return the orders of sale.
- 2. When the emergency subsides, the Court shall enter an order declaring an end to the emergency and a resumption of normal operations.
- 3. This "Temporary Order" is ordered to be served on the Supreme Court of Ohio, Ohio Judicial Conference, Sandusky County Bar Association, Sandusky County Prosecutor's

Office, Sandusky County Sheriff, Sandusky County Department of Health, Sandusky County Commissioners, Sandusky County website and media.
