**ORDER IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19
(CORONAVIRUS) PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS**

In response to the Governor Mike DeWine's Executive Order 2020-01D Declaring a State of Emergency regarding the COVID-19 public health emergency, on March 17, 2020, the Sixth District Court of Appeals filed a "Temporary Order in Response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Public Health Crisis." Pursuant to that Temporary Order, the Court orders as follows:



1. On March 22, 2020, the Director of the Ohio Department of Health issued a “Stay at Home Order,” requiring individuals to stay at home and all non-essential business operations to cease.

2. Pursuant to and in furtherance of the Ohio Department of Health’s Stay at Home Order, the Clerks of Court throughout the Sixth District Court of Appeals are authorized to accept notices of appeal, appellate briefs and other documents in appeals or original actions, currently prohibited by the Local Rules of the Sixth District Court of Appeals, for filing via facsimile and/or email until further order of the Court.
