
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS
ADDRESSING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

JOURNAL ENTRY MODIFYING
COURTHOUSE ADMISSION
PROCEDURES

Due to the recommendations of the Ohio Department of Health, the United States Center for Disease Control, Governor Mike DeWine, and Chief Justice Maureen O'Connor, the General and Domestic Relations Divisions of the Common Pleas Court will be implementing the following practices to safeguard parties, attorneys, staff, and the general public. These practices become effective on Monday, May 4, 2020, and will remain in effect until further notice.

1. Temperature Screenings. All persons entering the courthouse will be subjected to a mandatory temperature screening. This screening will be conducted at the security desk through the use of a contactless thermometer. Any individual that has a fever (100.4° F or higher) will be instructed to leave the courthouse immediately and security will communicate this information to the appropriate judicial staff member.
2. Masks/Face Coverings. All persons entering the courthouse will be required to wear a mask or other face covering.
