
ENTRY

This cause originated in this Court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus. Upon consideration of respondent's motion to dismiss, motion to declare relator a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. XIV, Section 5(B), and relator's request for oral hearing,

It is ordered by the Court that the motion to dismiss and motion to declare relator a vexatious litigator are granted. The request for oral hearing is denied as moot. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
