The following data is being provided pursuant to the request from the Task Force to examine the Ohio Bail System.

As part of the oversight of jails conducted by the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction / Bureau of Adult Detention, annual data is collected from the jails. While this data, doesn't include any information specific to bond, it does include inmate population numbers as well as the number of sentenced vs. unsentenced inmates.

These numbers are for Full Service and Minimum-Security Jails. For the most part, these are the typical "County Jails." They are for 2016-2018 and were calculated using the total number of inmates present in the jail on June 30<sup>th</sup> for each year. Please note, the "other" category includes federal inmates, APA holders, and DRC inmates.

Lastly, please remember the standard "cautions" when reviewing and/or sharing this information:

1. It is reported to the DRC by the jails.
2. There might be differences from jail to jail in the way the numbers are calculated
3. There is no independent verification of these numbers completed by the DRC.
