IN MANDAMUS AND PROHIBITION


ENTRY

This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for writs of mandamus and prohibition.

It is ordered by the court that respondents' requests to declare relator a vexatious litigator are granted and Carlean Dates is found to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B). Accordingly, it is ordered by the court that Carlean Dates is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of Supreme Court, or in person for the court's review.

Upon consideration of respondents' motions to dismiss, it is ordered by the court that the motions to dismiss are granted.

Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
