
This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of relator's motion to strike, motion to dismiss indictment, emergency request for immediate release, motions to disqualify Summit County Assistant Prosecuting Attorneys John Reece and Jennifer Piatt, motion to compel production of extradition records, governor's warrants, and arrest warrant and for enforcement of mandamus relief against respondents, motion for immediate release or, in the alternative, to vacate conviction and sentence, motion to declare judicial acts void, motion to certify federal constitutional questions, and motion to strike judgment for lack of jurisdiction and violation of original jurisdiction, it is ordered by the court that the motions are denied.

It is further ordered by the court that respondents' motions to declare relator a vexatious litigator are granted and J.C. Devar Sanders is found to be a vexatious litigator under Rule 4.03(B). Accordingly, it is ordered that J.C. Devar Sanders is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, or in person for the court's review.

It is further ordered that respondents' motions to dismiss are granted.

Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
