

The clerk's office categorizes cases according to the following designations:



The categories correspond to those used by Ohio's courts of appeal.


CASES BY CATEGORY




CASES FILED 2014-2018



CASES DISPOSED 2014-2018




CASES PENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER 2014-2018








Time to Disposition 2014-2018














Briefing to Oral Argument 2014-2018




