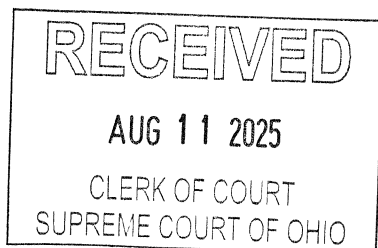

This matter was before the court on July 23, 2025 for a hearing on the complaint/comment letter of Donna K. Clary file stamped July 3, 2025 as well as a status conference/pretrial on a competency hearing. Present in court were Attorney David R. Cory, representing guardian Kristi R. Eader. Despite proper notice, Donna K. Clary failed to appear.

The court notes that from the evidence presented, the allegations of the complaint/comment letter of Donna K. Clary were unsubstantiated. In fact, the evidence presented demonstrated that Donna K. Clary directly interfered and obstructed the orders of this Court by aiding and abetting in secreting the ward out of its jurisdiction after she was placed under an emergency guardianship (which later became a full guardianship). The court considers said conduct to be a direct contempt of the orders of this court.

The court will pause to note that Donna K. Clary had also filed a letter complaining about the guardian on May 1, 2025. The court found that the same was essentially unwarranted, determined that no hearing was required and took no action on her letter. It based its decision upon said letter from Donna K. Clary, the reply of the guardian as well as the contents of the file.



Based upon the evidence presented as well as the failure of Donna K. Clary to appear to prosecute her complaint/comment letter the same is dismissed on the merits as well as for want of prosecution.

The court further finds pursuant to R.C. 2323.52 that Donna K. Clary is a vexatious litigator. As such, no letters or pleadings from her shall be considered going forward.

In conformity with R.C. 2323.52(H) the deputy clerk of this court shall send a certified copy of this entry to the supreme court for publication in a manner that the supreme court determines to be appropriate.

The court finds that based upon the evidence and record of this file, the guardian is well within her rights to prohibit communications between the ward Louis A. Henyan and Donna K. Clary going forward.

Finally, the court grants the guardian ninety (90) days to obtain an expert evaluation for the R.C. 2111.49(C) competency hearing herein. Said competency hearing is hereby scheduled on November 6, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. with no further notice to the parties from the court.
