JUDGMENT ENTRY

The matter came on for consideration this 27th day of March, 2025 before the Honorable Judge Nicholas J. Celebrezze for review of the Magistrate's Decision filed on March 13, 2025. Pursuant to Juv. R. 40(D)(4)(e) and Civ. R. 53(D)(4)(e), upon an independent review of the matter, the Court hereby enters judgement as follows:

The Court makes the following findings and orders:

The matter was before the court

Billy Coleman Jr. filed a Motion for Disclosure of Prior Psychiatric Hospitalization and Current Mental Health Compliance on March 4, 2025 and a Motion for Neutral Third Party Exchange, Medical Evaluation, and Review of Custody Arrangement on March 5, 2025. The motions are not warranted by existing law. The motions are denied.

Upon review of the court docket, the Court finds that Billy Coleman Jr., since February 20, 2024, filed fifty-nine motions. Forty-four of the motions were denied. Five were withdrawn by Billy Coleman Jr. or mooted by the Court. Three are still pending before Judge Celebrezze. Pursuant to Local Juvenile Rule 66(B) and R.C. 2323.52, this Court further finds that the father, Billy Coleman Jr., is a vexatious litigator.

Therefore, pursuant to Local Rule 66(B) and (C), Billy Coleman Jr., must seek leave of Court to proceed with any original or continual legal proceeding that is filed in this Court. Failure to seek leave of Court shall result in the dismissal of any action filed by Billy Coleman, Jr.
