DEFAULT JUDGMENT ENTRY

This matter is before the Court on the plaintiff's motion for default judgment against the defendant, Brandon Michael Jones. The Court finds that defendant was granted an extension until January 29, 2021, in which to answer, move, or otherwise respond to plaintiff's complaint. Defendant has failed to timely answer or file any type of responsive pleading.

The Court finds this matter is properly before it pursuant to R.C. 2323.52 (B), having been filed by the Lima City Law Director. Pursuant to R.C. 2323.52(C), the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure apply to this action.

The Court finds from the allegations in the complaint that defendant Jones has engaged in vexatious conduct as defined in R.C. 2323.52 (A)(2), and that Jones is a Vexatious Litigator as defined in R.C. 2323.52 (A)(3).



IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that defendant Brandon M. Jones is declared to be a vexatious litigator and is prohibited from doing the following without first obtaining the leave of that court to proceed:

- (a) Instituting legal proceedings in a court of common pleas or a municipal court;
- (b) Continuing any legal proceedings that defendant had instituted in any of the courts specified in (a) above prior to the entry of this order;
- (c) Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under R.C. 2323.52 (F) (1), in any legal proceedings instituted by him or another person in any of the courts specified in (a) above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant pay the costs of this action.
