JUDGMENT ENTRY

The matter came on for consideration this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2024 before the Honorable Judge Jennifer L. O'Malley for approval of the Magistrate's Decision filed on April 22, 2024. Pursuant to Juv. R. 40(D)(4)(e) and Civ. R. 53(D)(4)(e), upon an independent review of the matter, the Court hereby affirms, approves and adopts the Magistrate's Decision that was filed on April 22, 2024.

The Court makes the following findings and orders:

The matter was before the court

No parties were present. The Magistrate reviewed the pleadings and the court file.

Upon review of the court file, the Court finds that Mother, Chivon Oliver, filed a Motion to Show Cause on April 15, 2024, said Motion is dismissed.

The Court further finds that Mother, Chivon Oliver, has filed one hundred and six (106) Motions to Show Cause regarding the Child's private custody proceedings since 2013, all of which have been dismissed.

This Court further finds that Mother, Chivon Oliver, is a vexatious litigator pursuant to O.R.C. 2323.52 and Local Juvenile Rule 66.

Therefore, Mother must seek leave of Court to proceed with any original or continual legal proceeding that is filed in this Court. Failure to seek leave of Court shall result in the dismissal of any action filed by Mother, Chivon Oliver.
