Neuromodulation – Operation Wellness




- Veterans have higher rates than the general population of
 - mental health problems
 - substance use disorders
 - traumatic brain injury (TBI)
 - chronic pain conditions
 - suicide and homelessness

(Reimann 2018, Trivedi 2015, Fargo 2017)


- These conditions often occur together (Outcalt 2015), complicating treatment and recovery
- Veterans with untreated TBI and any mental health or substance use disorder are more likely to have behavioral and legal problems and attempt suicide
- Veteran suicides and legal problems are on the rise
- Evidence-based, personalized medicine, social support, and reintegration strategies to transform lives of veterans

Veterans NOW: WHY we are doing this – HB 166 provides access to novel TMS therapy



Veterans NOW: WHY we are doing this – CATALYST FOR CHANGE

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<u>Transcranial Magnetic Brain Stimulation (TMS):</u> **Pulses of magnetic fields** to brain areas involved in trauma and stress-related disorders (PTSD, TBI), mood, sleep, cognition, substance use; **retunes brain networks** <u>Off-label use of FDA-cleared device:</u> location, pattern, intensity, indication of TMS are investigational <u>EEG-calibrated/biometric feedback</u>: tune stimulation to each person's brain rhythms, monitor physiologic change

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- Comprehensive medical and psychosocial assessment
- Intensive Brain Stimulation (6 weeks) to facilitate participation and readiness for change
- Wellness Program (Diet, Exercise, Sleep, Mindfulness) with wearables / human performance analytics


INTEGRATED, MULTIDISCIPLINARY TREATMENT TEAM

- Medical: Board certified specialists in Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation, Neurorehabilitation and TBI, Neuromodulation, Addiction & Pain Medicine, Rehabilitation Psychology, Psychiatry, Nutrition, Pharmacy
- Complementary and Alternative Medicine, Restorative therapies: Pain-specialized physical therapists and Athletic trainers, OSU Exercise Is Medicine program, Integrative Medicine (Cranial Sacral Therapy, Massage, Mindfulness / Stress Reduction, Chiropractic, Yoga, Acupuncture), Wellness coaching
- Interactive Wellness app for goals / tracking performance
- Ecosystem of social support: RN Case Manager, Mental Health Counselors (Psychologist, LSW/LICDC), Veteran peers, Community Resources, Veteran Service Organizations
- Connection to state and county services to support socio-economic participation
- Intensive Brain Stimulation (6 weeks) to facilitate participation and readiness for change
- Wellness Program (Diet, Exercise, Sleep, Mindfulness) with wearables / human performance analytics

Veterans NOW: WHERE sites are/will be located

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- Sites near counties of Veteran population density
- Site 1: Outpatient, Central OSU, Columbus
- Site 2: Residential, dual diagnosis - Perry Behavioral Health Choices, New Lexington
- Sites 3-5: Northeast, Northwest, Southeast, Southwest Ohio



VISION: Sustainable, scalable, replicable Neuromodulation and Wellness program HB166: First taxpayer-funded program of its kind - Model for states

Veterans NOW: WHEN available

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Off-label TMS – Pending regulatory approval from FDA for formal launch

Central Ohio - Ohio State University outpatient location JANUARY 2021

New Lexington – Perry Behavioral Health Services residential location **FEBRUARY 2021**

Additional outpatient sites: JUNE 2021

Northeast – Cleveland area

Southwest – Cincinnati area

Northwest – Toledo area

Southeast – Barnesville area





Veterans NOW: WHO can participate

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- Legal Resident of Ohio
- US military Veteran (Active Duty, National Guard, or Reserves)
- Experiencing chronic trauma and stress-related disorder issues (e.g., mental health, substance use, TBI or chronic pain problems)
- Willing to commit to intensive program
- No prior diagnosis or medical referral is needed
- No out-of-pocket costs
- Exclusions: Uncontrolled medical, psychological or neurological conditions, absolute contraindications to TMS (ferromagnetic metal in head/neck), unwilling/unable to comply with protocol, does not meet Veteran or Ohio resident criteria

Veterans NOW: WHAT to expect

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- Veterans helping Veterans TEAM Argonaut contacts and hands off to site RN Case Manager:
 - Crisis referrals hotline
 - Basic needs
 - Ohio Veteran status (DD-214)
 - Benefits and records
 - Transportation needs
 - Program information and consent to share information with referring entities, as applicable
- Intensive assessment, then daily therapy for 6-8 weeks
 - 30 sessions of TMS *in person*
 - Weekly physician/CNP, mental health/substance counseling, nutrition, PT/Exercise is Medicine, massage
 - Daily RN, RN Case Manager, Veteran peer mentor contact
 - Interactive, personalized Wellness app with data tracking of trends
 - Telemedicine
- Transition to local resources for sustainability
- Total follow-up = 1 Year

2020 Examples

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2 Veteran courts referrals


<u>Case 1 (4/2020-6/2020)</u>: TBI (removed from theater), post-TBI cognitive impairment, back pain, SUD – methamphetamine, THC; jobless X 5 years, domestic violence complaint

<u>Case 2 (6/2020-8/2020)</u>: Blast injuries, multiple TBIs, chronic pain, SUD – alcohol, THC, lost job due to COVID, reported suicide attempt, domestic violence complaint; acute MCL injury week of program entry

<u>Both:</u> 30 sessions TMS + Wellness, (Wk 13-14) returned to work, abstinent, significantly improved health-related quality of life (VR-36)

Lessons learned: opportunity to divert / reduce recidivism

First 2 weeks critical need for extra support due to neurophysiological and emotional changes


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
