What is SBHP?

SBHP is a training, dissemination and referral system aimed at expanding access to trained behavioral health providers for service members, veterans and their families.



Star Behavioral Health Program Overview


















SBHP Objectives

- Provider training and referral program developed in 2011
- Increases access of service members, veterans, and families to high quality mental health care



 Builds National Guard personnel and civilian provider relationships


Train

Train civilian providers in military culture and evidence-based treatments

Create & Connect Create a registry where militaryconnected clients in need of support can connect with SBHP-trained providers

Engage & Serve Monitor engagement and increase military-connected clients served by SBHP registry providers






- 53% of all Active Duty SMs and family members identified as needing behavioral health services did not receive care.
- This lack of care could not be explained by the Military Health System.

SBHP Findings from First Five Years



- Participant rating of overall training: 4.36/5.00
- 48% participant reported knowledge gain across all 3 Tiers
- 58% actual knowledge gain across all 3 Tiers
- 48% of eligible attendees joined the registry
- Expansion in the number of providers who joined Tricare or Military OneSource


Tier Two

Tier One

Military culture & the deployment cycle

Tier One (1 day)



Training is open to professionals and community members interested in learning more about working with service members, veterans and their families.

Tier Two (two days)

Participants must have completed Tier One and be accepted into the <u>registry</u> to attend!



Tier Three (two days)

Participants must have completed both Tiers One and Two and be accepted into the <u>registry</u> to attend!

Skills-based training on evidence-based psychotherapies (EBPs) by topic:

- Cognitive Processing Therapy for PTSD
- Prolonged Exposure Therapy for PTSD
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Insomnia
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Depression
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Suicide Prevention
- Acceptance & Commitment Therapy
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Chronic Pain

Sustainment Trainings (2-4 hrs)

Tier S Trainings

 Address special topics on military-related behavioral health that are not covered in the tiered trainings



Examples

- Moral Injury
- Provider Sustainment & Self-Care
- Intimate Partner Violence
- Couples & the Deployment Cycle
- An Intervention for Treating Infidelity
- Circadian Rhythm Sleep-Wake Disorders





Consumer Information


