COURT INTERPRETER CERTIFICATION PROCEDURE

SIGN LANGUAGE INTERPRETER CERTIFICATION

INSTRUCTIONS

Certification of sign language interpreters is described in Superintendence Rule 82. Although there are many certifications available by national testing entities, the Supreme Court of Ohio selected the specialized credential, Specialist Certification: Legal, offered by the Registry of Interpreter for the Deaf, as the preferred credential for court interpretation. Holders of this specialist certificate demonstrate specialized knowledge of legal settings and superior familiarity with language used in the legal system. Prior to sitting for this exam, candidates are required to submit documented training and legal interpreting experience.

Candidates who wish to apply to receive Supreme Court of Ohio Sign Language certification must meet the following conditions:

- An application for certification as a Supreme Court certified sign language interpreter
- Verification of U.S. citizenship or legal residency, or legal right to remain and work in the United States
- Background check demonstrating no convictions on any crimes involving moral turpitude
- Proof of receiving a passing score on the "Specialist Certification: Legal" examination
- A signed Oath or affirmation acknowledging knowing, understanding and acting in accordance with the Code of Professional Conduct for Court Interpreters and Translators, as set forth in Appendix H to the Rules of Superintendence.

Additionally, in accordance with Superintendence Rule 85, a Supreme Court-certified sign language interpreter must complete and report at least 24 credit hours of continuing education offered or accredited by the Interpreter Services Program for each two-year reporting period, including six credit hours of ethics.

Candidates who meet the above-mentioned conditions will be placed in a statewide roster on the Supreme Court Web site and made available for assignments to all courts in Ohio.
