


Lesson 3: Court Interpreter Requirements

## Talent to Interpret




<u>Listen</u> to a speech in a source language within a specific context

Fully <u>comprehend</u> message and transfer it to the other language in your mind

Take notes

<u>Deliver</u> the complete message in the target language

## Interpreting Strategies and Techniques



Interpreting techniques: the tool kit. Interpreters consciously decide to:

- 1. Listen to a message in the source language
- 2. Decide how to process that information while actively using short term memory
- 3. Take notes (what to include)
- 4. Pace themselves while delivering the same message in the target language.
