Contemporaneous with the filing of this Declaration is the filing of "Judgment Entry and Order" in the case of *Joseph P. Ebbing, et al. v. ORDER TO JOSEPH P. EBBING: Based on this declaration, it is ordered that Mr. Ebbing is prohibited from doing any of the following without first obtaining leave to proceed from the Butler County Court of Common Pleas:


- (a) Instituting legal proceedings in the court of claims or in a court of common pleas, municipal court, or county court;
- (b) Continuing any legal proceedings that he instituted in any of the courts specified in paragraph (a), above, prior to the entry of this Declaration;
- (c) Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under R.C. Section 2323.52(F)(1), in any legal

proceedings instituted by him or another person in any of the courts specified in paragraph (a), above.
