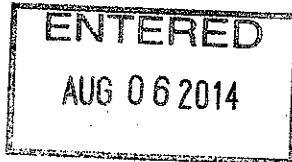

Petitioner Yvette Williams has filed five petitions for a civil stalking protection order against Respondent Robert Cook in cases SK1200918, SK1300318, SK1300353, SK1400359, and SK1400548. In the various cases, Yvette Williams has alleged her ex-husband Robert Cook has electronically spied on her, installed listening devices in her home, forced himself upon her, and entered her home without her permission. In case SK1400548, Yvette Williams issued numerous subpoenas to witnesses and entities in an attempt to support her allegations. Many witnesses and entities attempted to comply with the subpoenas despite their burdensome requests and spurious nature. At the hearing on July 30, 2014, the court found the information sought by Yvette Williams had little, if any, relevance to the issuance of a protection order.

Furthermore, Yvette Williams has previously filed over thirty (30) petitions for a civil stalking protection order against other individuals. All of these cases were dismissed because the allegations were not supported by the evidence and without merit. Ironically, some of the same individuals she has filed against in the past were subpoenaed


in this case to support her allegations. Yvette Williams has put tremendous strain on all those she has filed against and subpoenaed. Because she has abused the court system and the community at large with frivolous, baseless filings, the court finds Yvette Williams is a vexatious litigator.

Pursuant to O.R.C. 2323.52, this court finds that Yvette Williams is prohibited from doing the following without first obtaining leave of court to proceed:

- (a) Instituting legal proceedings in a court of common pleas;
- (b) Continuing any legal proceedings that the plaintiff had instituted in a court of common pleas prior to the entry of this order;
- (c) Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed pursuant to O.R.C. 2323.52(F), in any legal proceedings instituted by the plaintiff or another person in a court of common pleas.
