

This matter came before the Court upon the motion of Defendant for summary judgment and the Plaintiff's motion to dismiss the court's order requiring Plaintiff to show cause as to why he should not be declared a vexation litigator.

Pursuant to Civ. R. 56, Defendant's motion for summary judgment is granted based upon the evidence presented. Further, Plaintiff's response fails to show that there is an issue for trial. Summary judgment, being appropriate is granted in favor of Defendant.
