OPINION AND ORDER

Federal Bureau of Investigation,

Pro se Plaintiff Joseph Emerson filed this action in the Toledo Municipal Court against the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI"). Defendant removed the case to federal court and filed a Motion to Dismiss (Doc. No. 4). The Complaint consists entirely of rambling, incoherent, stream-of-consciousness narrative. Plaintiff also filed a supplement written in the same manner. Because the Complaint does not include a lucid statement of fact or an identifiable legal claim, the Court need not address the Motion to Dismiss.

A district court may, at any time, *sua sponte* dismiss a Complaint when the allegations of the Complaint "are totally implausible, attenuated, unsubstantial, frivolous, devoid of merit, or no longer open to discussion." *Apple v. Glenn*, 183 F.3d 477, 479 (6th Cir. 1999) (citing *Hagans v. Lavine*, 415 U.S. 528, 436-37 (1974)); *see Hassink v. Mottl*, 47 Fed.Appx. 753, 755 (6th Cir. 2002) (holding that district court properly dismissed the case *sua sponte* for lack of subject matter jurisdiction where the plaintiff's complaint lacked an arguable basis in law). Because Plaintiff has not included any element of a Complaint needed to meet basic notice pleading requirements, this action is dismissed. Case: 3:20-cv-01634-JGC Doc #: 8 Filed: 12/01/20 2 of 4. PageID #: 183

Furthermore, Plaintiff is a familiar litigant in the Northern District of Ohio. He filed eleven actions prior to this one, which were all dismissed as frivolous. See Emerson v. Local 50 Northwestern Ohio Plumbers and Pipefitters, No. 3:15-cv-02074 (N.D. Ohio Nov. 17, 2015); Emerson v. Chrysler Headquarters et al, No. 3:18-cv-02137 (N.D. Ohio Jan. 11, 2019); Emerson v. Hilton Worldwide Global Headquarters et al, No. 3:18-cv-02796 (N.D. Ohio Jan. 11, 2019); Emerson v. Dept. of Public Utilities, No. 3:19-cv-00351 (N.D. Ohio July 31, 2019); Emerson v. Williams et al, No. 3:19-cv-00365 (N.D. Ohio Jan, 2, 2020); Emerson v. Beal, No. 3:19-cv-00366 (N.D. Ohio Mar. 11, 2019); Emerson v. CBS Headquarter et al, No. 3:19-cv-00414 (N.D. Ohio May 29, 2019); Emerson v. Myler, No. 3:19-cv-00425 (N.D. Ohio Dec. 30, 2019); Emerson v. Hebb, No. 3:19-cv-00460 (N.D. Ohio Mar. 28, 2019); Emerson v. City of Monroe et al, No. 3:19-cv-00461 (N.D. Ohio Dec. 30, 2019); Emerson v. Facebook et al, No. 3:19-cv-00475 (N.D. Ohio Mar. 19, 2019). Due to his pattern if vexatious litigation, he has been barred from proceeding with a new action unless he pays the full filing fee. He is barred from proceeding in forma pauperis. Emerson v. Facebook et al, No. 3:19-cv-00475 (N.D. Ohio Mar. 19, 2019). Undeterred, he filed this case in state court from which Defendant removed it.

It is therefore necessary to impose further filing restrictions on Plaintiff. He is permanently enjoined from filing any new lawsuits or other documents without seeking and obtaining leave of court from the Chief Judge or the Miscellaneous Duty Judge in accordance with the following:

> 1. He must file a Motion Pursuant to Court Order Seeking Leave to File with any document he proposes to file and he must attach a copy of this Order to it (any such Motion should be filed in a miscellaneous case).

> 2. As an exhibit to any Motion seeking such leave, he must also attach a declaration which has been prepared pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746 or a sworn affidavit certifying that (1) the document raises a new issue which has never been previously raised by his in this or any other court, (2) the

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claim or issue is not frivolous, and (3) the document is not filed in bad faith.

3. By means of a second exhibit, he must identify and list: (a) the full caption of each and every suit which has been previously filed by him or on his behalf in any Court against each and every Defendant in any new suit he wishes to file, and (b) the full caption of each and every suit which he has currently pending.

4. As a third exhibit to the Motion, he must provide a copy of each Complaint identified and listed in accordance with the foregoing paragraph 3 and a certified record of its disposition.

The Court may deny any Motion for leave to file if the proposed document is frivolous, vexatious or harassing. If the Motion is denied, the document shall not be filed. Further, Plaintiff's failure to comply with the terms of this Order shall be sufficient ground for this Court to deny any Motion for leave to file, and may be considered an act of contempt for which he may be punished accordingly. If Plaintiff files the action in state court and it is removed to federal court by the Defendant, it will be dismissed without further notice by the Court unless Plaintiff immediately files the Motion for leave to proceed and attaches the three exhibits as set forth above.

Further, to prevent future harassment by Plaintiff and the waste of this Court's limited resources, the Clerk's Office is hereby ordered that it shall not accept any document submitted by Plaintiff prior to him obtaining leave to file. The Clerk's Office shall not file any Motion for leave unless it is *specifically identified* as a "Motion Pursuant to Court Order Seeking Leave to File," and unless it contains the attachments required by this Order. The Clerk's Office shall not accept any other documents from Plaintiff until the Motion Pursuant to Court Order Seeking Leave to File is granted.

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Accordingly, this action is dismissed. The Court certifies pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1915(a)(3) that an appeal from this decision could not be taken in good faith.¹ In addition, Plaintiff is permanently enjoined from filing additional actions or prosecuting additional actions in this Court without first obtaining leave of court as set forth in this Memorandum of Opinion and Order.

INTRODUCTION

Plaintiff *pro se* Joseph Emerson filed this Complaint against Facebook, United Association, FBI Headquarters, and Norwegian Cruise Lines (Doc. 2). The Complaint consists entirely of a rambling, stream-of-consciousness narrative. Since filing the Complaint on March 4, 2019, Emerson has filed three Supplements (Docs. 4, 5, 6) written in the same manner as the Complaint.

LEGAL STANDARD

Pro se pleadings are liberally construed. Boag v. MacDougall, 454 U.S. 364, 365 (1982); Haines v. Kerner, 404 U.S. 519, 520 (1972). This Court, however, is required to dismiss a pro se complaint if it fails to state a claim upon which relief may be granted or lacks an arguable basis in law or fact. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2); Neitzke v. Williams, 490 U.S. 319, 328 (1989). An action has no arguable basis in law when a defendant is immune from suit or when a plaintiff claims a violation of a legal interest which clearly does not exist. Williams, 490 U.S. at 327. An action has no arguable basis in fact when the allegations are "delusional" or "wholly incredible." Denton v. Hernandez, 504 U.S. 25, 32–33 (1992) (citation omitted). Case: 3:19-cv-00475-JZ Doc #: 7 Filed: 03/19/19 2 of 4. PageID #: 37

At the pleading stage, this Court construes the Complaint in the light most favorable to Emerson, accepts all factual allegations as true, and determines whether the Complaint contains "enough facts to state a claim to relief that is plausible on its face." *Bell Atl. Corp. v. Twombly*, 550 U.S. 544, 570 (2007). But this Court need not accept as true allegations that are "clearly baseless," such as claims that are fanciful, delusional, wholly incredible, or irrational. *Denton*, 504 U.S. at 32–33. A claim is plausible when the Complaint contains "factual content that allows the court to draw the reasonable inference that the defendant is liable for the misconduct alleged." *Ashcroft v. Iqbal*, 556 U.S. 662, 678 (2009). At a minimum, the Complaint must give Defendants fair notice of what Emerson's claims are and the factual grounds upon which they rest. *Bassett v. Nat'l Collegiate Athletic Ass'n*, 528 F.3d 426, 437 (6th Cir. 2008).

DISCUSSION

This case lacks an arguable basis in law and fact. Neither the Complaint nor the Supplements contain any decipherable legal claims or requests for relief. This Court is not required to conjure up questions never squarely presented to it or to construct full blown claims from sentence fragments. *Martin v. Overton*, 391 F.3d 710, 714 (6th Cir. 2004); *Beaudett v. City of Hampton*, 775 F.2d 1274, 1278 (4th Cir. 1985). The Complaint does not meet the basic pleading requirements and must be dismissed under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e).

Emerson is a familiar litigant in the Northern District of Ohio and, in all cases filed, he has sought to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Emerson recently filed three other lawsuits, in addition to this one, in which he was granted leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* and which were dismissed pursuant to Section 1915(e) or for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Those cases are: Case No. 3:18-cv-2137-JZ (*Emerson v. Chrysler Headquarters, et al.*) (dismissed under Section 1915(e) and enjoined from filing further documents in the case due to pattern of filing frivolous and vexatious materials); Case: 3:19-cv-00475-JZ Doc #: 7 Filed: 03/19/19 3 of 4. PageID #: 38

Case No. 3:18-cv-2796-JZ (Emerson v. Hilton Worldwide Global Headquarters, et al.) (same); Case No. 3:19-cv-366-JGC (Emerson v. Beal) (dismissed for lack of subject matter jurisdiction).

And there are more *in forma pauperis* actions filed by Emerson that are still pending in this District. Those cases are: Case No. 3:19-cv-351-JJH (*Emerson v. Department of Public Utilities*); Case No. 3:19-cv-365-JJH (*Emerson v. Williams, et al.*); Case No. 3:19-cv-414-JGC (*Emerson v. CBS Headquarters, et al.*); Case No. 3:19-cv-425-JJH (*Emerson v. Myler, et al.*); Case No. 3:19-cv-460-JGC (*Emerson v. Hebb*); and Case No. 3:19-cv-461-JJH (*Emerson v. City of Monroe, et al.*).

Altogether, Emerson has filed ten lawsuits in the Northern District of Ohio in under six months. Eight of these lawsuits were filed in the first three months of 2019. Of the ten, four (including this one) were dismissed before service of process, and six are pending.

Proceeding *in forma pauperis* is a privilege, not a right. *Wilson v. Yaklich*, 148 F.3d 596, 603 (6th Cir. 1998). The repeated filing of meritless lawsuits diverts judicial resources, interferes with the orderly administration of justice, and is incompatible with the privilege of proceeding *in forma pauperis. See Moore v. Controlled Substances Act*, 2006 WL 1313880, at *1 (W.D. Mich. 2006). "[F]ederal courts have the inherent power to impose appropriate sanctions, including restrictions on future access to the judicial system, to deter future frivolous, harassing, or duplicative lawsuits." *Lawrence v. Bevin*, 2017 WL 1103616, at *3 (W.D. Ky. 2017) (citing *Chambers v. Nasco, Inc.*, 501 U.S. 32, 43–45 (1991); *Futernick v. Sumpter Twp.*, 207 F.3d 305, 314 (6th Cir. 2000); *Filipas v. Lemons*, 835 F.2d 1145, 1146 (6th Cir. 1987)). This inherent power includes denying the privilege of proceeding as a pauper when a litigant abuses the privilege by repeatedly filing meritless lawsuits. *See In re McDonald*, 489 U.S. 180, 184–85 (1989); *Maxberry v. S.E.C.*, 879 F.2d 222, 224 (6th Cir. 1989).

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This Court has a responsibility to ensure that the judiciary's resources are allocated in a manner that advances the interests of justice. Given Emerson's history of filing multiple lawsuits in this District in quick succession -- with none yet found to have merit in federal court -- this Court concludes that allowing Emerson to continue to file lawsuits in this District without payment of the filing fee does not promote the use of court resources in the interest of justice. *See Maxberry*, 879 F.2d at 224. Accordingly, in the future, Plaintiff Joseph Emerson will no longer be permitted to file civil lawsuits in this District without paying the full filing fee.

CONCLUSION

Emerson's Motion to Proceed in Forma Pauperis (Doc. 2) is granted, but if Emerson desires to pursue future litigation in the Northern District of Ohio, he will be required to pay the full filing fee.

This action is dismissed under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). This Court certifies, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an appeal from this decision could not be taken in good faith.

Emerson is enjoined from filing any further documents, letters, or supplements in this case due to his clear pattern of filing materials that are "patently frivolous and vexatious" and that "abuse the judicial process." *Kissi v. Clement*, 2008 WL 7526326, at *5 (N.D. Ohio 2008).

This appeal is before the court sua sponte. Appellant, Joseph Emerson, filed a notice of appeal from the August 26, 2022 judgment of the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas, that dismissed appellant's complaint as to defendant-appellee Local 421 only. For the following reasons, the appeal is dismissed for lack of a final, appealable order.

The record reflects that on May 27, 2022, appellant filed a complaint against defendants Local 421, Local 50, Local 636, Local 671, and BP Husky Refinery. In a judgment journalized on July 22, 2022, the complaint as to Local 636 was dismissed.

Neither the July 22, 2022 judgment dismissing defendant Local 636, nor the August 26, 2022 judgment from which this appeal is taken, contain a Civ.R. 54(B) determination that there is "no just reason for delay" and, therefore, a final, appealable order has not yet been entered. *Noble v. Colwell*, 44 Ohio St.3d 92, 540 N.E.2d 1381 (1989), states, "An order which adjudicates one or more but fewer than all the claims or the rights and liabilities of fewer than all the parties must meet the requirements of R.C. 2505.02 and Civ.R. 54(B) in order to be final and appealable." *Id.* at syllabus.

Civ.R. 54(B) states:

Judgment Upon Multiple Claims or Involving Multiple Parties. When more than one claim for relief is presented in an action, whether as a claim, counterclaim, cross-claim or third-party claim, and whether arising out of the same or separate transactions, or when multiple parties are involved, the court may enter final judgment as to one or more but fewer than all of the claims or parties only upon an express determination that there is no just reason for delay. In the absence of a determination that there is no just reason for delay, any order or other form of decision, however designated, which adjudicates fewer than all the claims or the rights and liabilities of fewer than all the parties, shall not terminate the action as to any of the claims or parties, and the order or other form of decision is subject to revision at any time

before the entry of judgment adjudicating all the claims and the rights and liabilities of all the parties.

The trial court's judgment from which appellant has appealed does not dispose of all the claims between all of the parties and does not contain a determination that there is no just reason for delay. Because appellant's complaint against defendants Local 50, Local 671, and BP Husky Refinery remain pending, the appeal is dismissed for lack of a final, appealable order. Appellant is ordered to pay the costs of this appeal pursuant to App.R. 24.

It is so ordered.



Here, Plaintiff's complaint fails to include factual allegations setting forth the elements of any legal claim against any defendant, let alone AWC. In fact, Plaintiff's complaint makes only one statement against AWC: "AWC put two females a protection game as FBI interstate has me a drug dealer fabrication thirty years" and prays for "ten million in damages for buying out the IRS whistleblowers I turned in embezzling vehicles and interfering with FBI my work related places stalked and called for games sex. They also rigged my knee which blocked the second appointment a MRI." Plaintiff's allegations and prayer for relief amount to no more than conclusory declarations, unsupported by factual allegations. They are insufficient to withstand a motion to dismiss.

What is more, Plaintiff has filed around 20 lawsuits in the Lucas County Common Pleas Court since May 2021. These lawsuits have similar incoherent and rambling allegations against various individuals and entities, and a majority, if not all, were dismissed under Civ.R. 12(B). This complaint is no different—it is a frivolous filing and "prevent[s] the speedy consideration of proper litigation." *Mayer v. Bristow*, 91 Ohio St.3d 3, 13, 740 N.E.2d 656 (2000)(court are not the place for vexatious or frivolous pro-se lawsuits).

For these reasons, AWC requests that this Court dismiss Plaintiff's complaint with prejudice.




