MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2010-0375. State ex rel. Knowlton v. Noble Cty. Bd. of Elections, Slip Opinion No. 2010-Ohio-1115.

In Mandamus and Prohibition. Writ of prohibition granted. Petition for writ of mandamus dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

Lundberg Stratton, O'Connor, O'Donnell, and Lanzinger, JJ., concur.

Moyer, C.J., and Cupp, J., concur in the dismissal of the mandamus claim but dissent from the grant of the writ of prohibition.

Pfeifer, J., concurs in part and dissents in part.
