DISCIPLINARY CASES

2008-1573. Disciplinary Counsel v. Brown.

On January 25, 2011, upon consideration of Disciplinary Counsel's Motion for Order to Appear and Show Cause, this court found respondent, Bruce A. Brown, a.k.a. B. Andrew Brown, a.k.a. Amir Jamal Tauwab, in contempt of this court's order to pay a \$50,000 civil penalty in this matter. The contempt order required respondent to submit to a debtor's exam to be conducted by the Office of the Ohio Attorney General within 45 days of the date of the order.

It is ordered by the court that the parties shall file memoranda with the court informing the court of the current status of these proceedings. The memoranda shall be filed within ten days of the date of this order.
