MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2011-2123. State v. Hawkins.

Hamilton App. No. C-110291, 2011-Ohio-5645. This cause was filed as a postconviction death penalty appeal from the Hamilton County Court of Appeals. Upon review of appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction it is apparent that appellant's death sentence has been commuted to life without parole. Therefore, this cause will no longer proceed as a postconviction death penalty appeal, but shall instead proceed as a discretionary appeal and claimed appeal of right pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 2.1(A)(2) and (3).

It is ordered by the court that appellant shall file an amended memorandum in support of jurisdiction, limited to 15 pages, within ten days of the date of this entry.
