## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2012-0954. Ries v. Ohio State Univ. Med. Ctr.**

Franklin App. No. 11AP-1004, 2012-Ohio-1766. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of appellant and amicus curiae the Ohio Association for Justice's motion to present oral argument, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Amicus curiae, the Ohio Association for Justice, shall share the time allotted to appellant.

**2013-0441. State ex rel. Lowe v. Callahan.**

Summit App. No. 26758. This cause was filed as a discretionary appeal. Upon consideration of appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction, it is determined by the court that this cause originated in the court of appeals and, therefore, should proceed as an appeal of right pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 5.01.

It is ordered by the court that the clerk shall issue an order for the transmission of the record from the Court of Appeals for Summit County, and the parties shall otherwise proceed in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02 through 16.07.
