## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2012-0169. Stammco, L.L.C. v. United Tel. Co. of Ohio.**

Fulton App. No. F-11-003, 2011-Ohio-6503. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Fulton County.

Upon consideration of appellees' motion for leave to submit documents referred to during the February 6, 2013 oral arguments, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

## DISCIPLINARY CASES

### **2000-1100. Disciplinary Counsel v. Oglesby.**

On January 31, 2013, respondent, Geoffrey Lynn Oglesby, filed an application for termination of probation. Upon consideration thereof, the court finds that respondent has substantially complied with Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D) and with its order, dated January 26, 2012, in which the court reinstated respondent to the practice of law and placed him on monitored probation for a period of one year.

On consideration thereof, it is ordered by this court that the probation of respondent, Geoffrey Lynn Oglesby, Attorney Registration No. 0023949, last known business address in Sandusky, Ohio, is terminated.

It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(1), that publication be made as provided for in Gov.Bar R. V(8)(D)(2), and that respondent bear the costs of publication.

**2010-2199. Disciplinary Counsel v. Johnson.**

On application for reinstatement of Frederick Bruce Johnson, Attorney Registration No. 0003093. The application is granted, and respondent is reinstated to the practice of law in Ohio.

**MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS**

**2013-0153. Dalm Land Ltd. v. Summit Cty. Bd. of Revision.**

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2012-A-4367. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of appellant's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
