MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2014-0273. State v. Clinton.

Erie C.P. No. 2012-CR-383. This cause is pending before the court as a death-penalty appeal from the Court of Common Pleas for Erie County.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion to unseal the record, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied. It is further ordered, sua sponte, that counsel in this case shall be permitted to come to the clerk's office to review the sealed portions of the record.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2014-1102. State v. Sexton.

Montgomery App. No. 25862, 2014-Ohio-2314. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal. On June 30, 2014, when this appeal was filed, a check in the amount of \$100 was submitted by appellant to satisfy the requirement of the docket fee imposed by R.C. 2503.17 and S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.04. This court has been informed by the Office of the Treasurer of the State of Ohio that the check was returned because of insufficient funds.

R.C. 2503.17 and S.Ct.Prac.R. 3.04 require that the docket fee shall be paid before a notice of appeal is filed or a case is docketed. Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is dismissed.

2014-1111. State ex rel. Bunting v. Styer.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of relator's application for dismissal, it is ordered by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.
