2013-0382. State v. Gilbert, Slip Opinion No. 2014-Ohio-4562.

Hamilton App. No. C-110382, 2013-Ohio-238. Judgment affirmed.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2014-0851. Freedom Mtge. Corp. v. Vitale.

Tuscarawas App. No. 2013 AP 08 0037, 2014-Ohio-1549. Upon consideration of the jurisdictional memoranda filed in this case, the court declines to accept jurisdiction of the appeal pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.08(B)(4).

Upon consideration of appellants' motion for stay of sale, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

2014-1026. Dublin City Schools Bd. of Edn. v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2013-4353. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand the appeal to the Board of Tax Appeals to implement a settlement agreement, it is ordered by the court that the cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals to take further action as appropriate.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the Board of Tax Appeals.

2014-1123. State ex rel. Lucas Cty. Republican Party Executive Commt. v. Husted.

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that respondent shall submit to the clerk's office eight new copies of "Respondent's Evidence Volume VI" within seven days of the date of this entry.
