## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2014-1278. State v. Earley.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 100482, 2014-Ohio-2643. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court case No. 2014-1454, *State v. Earley*, and that the briefing in case Nos. 2014-1278 and 2014-1454 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02 through 16.04 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.01 through 16.04. The briefing schedule shall remain the same.

### **2014-1454. State v. Earley.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 100482, 2014-Ohio-2643. This cause is pending before the court as a certified conflict from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that this cause is consolidated with Supreme Court case No. 2014-1278, *State v. Earley*, and that the briefing in case Nos. 2014-1454 and 2014-1278 shall be consolidated. The parties shall file two originals of each of the briefs permitted under S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.02 through 16.04 and include both case numbers on the cover page of the briefs. The parties shall otherwise comply with the requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. 16.01 through 16.04. The briefing schedule shall remain the same.

## DISCIPLINARY CASES

### **2014-1403. Trumbull Cty. Bar Assn. v. Johnson.**

This cause is pending before the court upon the filing of a certification of default by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline. Respondent was ordered to show cause why an interim default-judgment suspension should not be imposed. Respondent filed objections and a brief in support and this cause was considered by the court.

Upon consideration thereof, it is ordered by the court that this matter is remanded to the board for further proceedings under Gov.Bar R. V(6a)(F).
