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## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2014-2190. In re A.G.**

Cuyahoga App. No. 101010, 2014-Ohio-4927. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion to file under seal the waiver of memorandum in response, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.

### **2015-0075. TIC Sterling Place I, L.L.C. v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Revision.**

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 2012-905, 2012-906, and 2012-1051. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand the appeal to the Board of Tax Appeals in order to implement a settlement, it is ordered by the court that the cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals to take further action as appropriate.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the Board of Tax Appeals.

### **2015-0914. In re Application of N. Coast Transm., L.L.C. for a Certificate Relative to the Oregon Lateral Pipeline.**

Power Siting Board, No. 14-1754-GA-BLN. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Power Siting Board.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion to strike the Ohio Power Siting Board's motion to dismiss, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

Hamilton App. No. C-140398, 2015-Ohio-2114. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of the motion for admission pro hac vice of Marsha L. Levick, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.
