MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2014-1063. Taft v. Lorain Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2011-3401. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

Upon consideration of the joint motion to remand the appeal to the Board of Tax Appeals, it is ordered by the court that the cause is remanded to the Board of Tax Appeals to take further action as appropriate.

It is further ordered that a mandate be sent to and filed with the Board of Tax Appeals.

2014-1161. World Harvest Church v. Grange Mut. Cas. Co.

Franklin App. No. 13AP-290, 2014-Ohio-5707. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Franklin County.

Upon review of the brief of amicus curiae United Policyholders in support of appellee, it is evident that Timothy P. Law, Anthony B. Crawford, and Amy Back have not filed timely motions for admission pro hac vice pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 2.02. Therefore, it is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that Timothy P. Law, Anthony B. Crawford, and Amy Back are stricken from the brief of amicus curiae United Policyholders in support of appellee for failure to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 2.02 and Gov.Bar R. XII(2)(A)(6)(a) through (e).
