MERIT DECISIONS WITH OPINIONS

2016-0265. Cleveland Metro. Bar Assn. v. Frenden, Slip Opinion No. 2016-Ohio-7198.

On Certified Report by the Board of Professional Conduct, No. 2015-015. John Barry Frenden, Attorney Registration No. 0076200, is hereby permanently disbarred from the practice of law in Ohio.

O'Connor, C.J., and Pfeifer, Lanzinger, French, and O'Neill, JJ., concur.

O'Donnell and Kennedy, JJ., dissent and would indefinitely suspend respondent.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2011-0093. State v. Ketterer.

Butler C.P. No. CR2003030309. This cause came for further consideration upon appellant's filing of a motion for stay of execution of death sentence pending disposition of available state remedies.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion to stay execution of death sentence pending disposition of available state remedies, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted. It is further ordered that this stay shall remain in effect until exhaustion of all state postconviction proceedings, including any appeals.

2016-0646. Johnson v. Moore.

Warren App. No. CA2016-02-011. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Warren County.

Upon consideration of appellant's motion for appointment of counsel, it is ordered by the court that the motion is denied.

2016-0979. State ex rel. Sultaana v. Am. Honda Fin. Corp.

In Mandamus. This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of relator's emergency motion to proceed to judgment. It is ordered by the court that the motion is denied as moot.

2016-1252. Preterm-Cleveland, Inc. v. Kasich.

Cuyahoga App. No. 103103, 2016-Ohio-4859. This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of the motions for admission pro hac vice of Lorie Chaiten and Jennifer Lee, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.
