## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2017-0079. State ex rel. Delaware Joint Vocational School Dist. Bd. of Edn. v. Testa.**

In Mandamus. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus.

Upon consideration of relator's unopposed motion for expedited consideration, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted.

It is further ordered by the court that an alternative writ is granted and the following briefing schedule is set for presentation of evidence and filing of briefs pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.05.

Relator shall file its merit brief and evidence within seven days of the date of this entry; respondent shall file his merit brief and evidence within seven days after the filing of relator's brief; and relator may file a reply brief within five days after the filing of respondent's brief.

It is further ordered that the requirement for respondent to file a response to the complaint pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.04(A) is waived.
