MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2016-1427. Realty Income Properties 24, L.L.C. v. Delaware Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, Nos. 2015-2413 and 2015-2414. At oral argument before a master commissioner on June 19, 2018, the parties in this case indicated that they have reached a settlement. Within 14 days, the parties shall file either an application for dismissal or a notice of failure of settlement.

2017-1666. State ex rel. Dunn v. Court of Common Pleas.

Franklin App. No. 14AP-819, 2017-Ohio-7679. Pursuant to R.C. 2710.06(B)(1), the court has been notified that the parties in this case have reached a settlement. The case is returned to the regular docket under S.Ct.Prac.R. 19.01. Within 60 days, appellant shall file an application for dismissal or file a merit brief in accordance with Supreme Court Rules of Practice. This case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or merit brief is not filed within 60 days.
