MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2018-0638. State v. Whitaker.

Cuyahoga C.P. No. CR-17-614021. On appellant's motion for extension of time to transmit the record. Motion granted. The record shall be filed no later than September 6, 2018.

2018-1025. Gerston v. Parma VTA, L.L.C.

Cuyahoga App. No. 105572, 2018-Ohio-2185. On motion for admission pro hac vice of William M. Hensley. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2018-0822. Warren Cty. Bar Assn. v. Brenner.

On certification of default. Andrew Jay Brenner, Attorney Registration No. 0085066, last known address in Mason, Ohio, suspended from the practice of law for an interim period.

Kennedy, French, and DeWine, JJ., dissent.

2018-0822. Warren Cty. Bar Assn. v. Brenner.

On respondent's objections to the certification of default. Objections sustained in part and respondent granted leave to file his answer with the Board of Professional Conduct. Matter remanded to the board for further proceedings under Gov.Bar R. V(12). The court further orders that the interim default suspension imposed

against respondent on this date shall remain in place while this matter is pending before the board. Proceedings before this court in this case are stayed until further order of this court.
