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## DISCIPLINARY CASES

**2019-0660. In re Resignation of Packard.**

On application for retirement or resignation of Jerry Steven Packard, Attorney Registration No. 0013965, last known business address in Wooster, Ohio. Resignation accepted with disciplinary action pending.

**2019-0683. In re Resignation of Cicero.**

On application for retirement or resignation of Christopher Thomas Cicero, Attorney Registration No. 0039882, last known business address in Columbus, Ohio. Application denied pursuant to Gov.Bar R. VI(11)(C).

**2019-0762. In re Schuman.**

On certified entry of felony conviction. Respondent and disciplinary counsel ordered to show cause within 20 days why an interim felony suspension should not be imposed.

## MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

**2019-0417. State v. Shoecraft.**

Montgomery App. No. 27860, 2018-Ohio-3920. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due June 14, 2019, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

**2019-0443. State v. Michaels.**

Mahoning App. No. 17 MA 0122, 2019-Ohio-497. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due June 14, 2019, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.
