MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2020-0327. State ex rel. Ohioans for Secure & Fair Elections v. LaRose.

In Mandamus. On motion for admission pro hac vice of Dale E. Ho. Motion granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file a notice of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days. Motion for admission pro hac vice of T. Alora Thomas denied for failure to attach the affidavit required by Gov.Bar. R. XII(2)(A)(6). T. Alora Thomas may refile a compliant motion for pro hac vice admission.

2020-0414. State ex rel. Padilla-Marquez v. Jones.

In Habeas Corpus. On respondent's motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim. Motion denied as moot.

2020-0423. Ohio State Bar Assn. v. Timberwolf Litigation & Research Servs., L.L.C.

On motion to show cause filed by relator, Ohio State Bar Association. Respondent, Timberwolf Litigation and Research Services, L.L.C., ordered to show cause by filing a written response with the clerk of this court within ten days why respondent should not be held in contempt.
