MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2020-0975. State v. Bristow.

Richland App. No. 2020 CA 0006, 2020-Ohio-3999. On appellant's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

2020-0993. State v. Valois-Perez.

Sandusky App. Nos. S-19-005 and S-19-023, 2020-Ohio-3755. On appellant's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

2020-1105. State v. Wilson.

Clark App. No. 2018-CA-2, 2020-Ohio-2962. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due October 22, 2020, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.
