2020-0368. *State v. Jones*, Slip Opinion No. 2021-Ohio-3311.

Hamilton App. No. C-170647, 2020-Ohio-281. Judgment reversed in part and cause remanded to the trial court.

O'Connor, C.J., and Kennedy and DeWine, JJ., concur.

Fischer, J., concurs in judgment only.

Donnelly, J., dissents, with an opinion joined by Brunner, J.

Stewart, J., would dismiss the appeal as having been improvidently accepted.

MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2013-0921. Akron Bar Assn. v. Walkley.

On relator's motion for an order to appear and show cause and appointment of counsel for respondent. Motion for appointment of counsel granted. Peter T. Cahoon appointed to represent respondent on a pro bono basis. Respondent ordered to show cause by filing a written response with the clerk of this court within 20 days why he should not be held in contempt for failure to fully comply with this court's September 5, 2013 order.

2018-1265. State v. Kirkland.

Hamilton C.P. No. B 0901629. On appellant's motion for stay of execution of death sentence pending disposition of his available state remedies. Motion granted. The stay shall remain in effect until exhaustion of all state postconviction proceedings, including any appeals.

2021-1118. Appellant B. v. Liberty Mut. Fire Ins. Co.

Cuyahoga App. No. 110032. On appellant's "instant motion for leave to file utilizing initials and redacted documents/file under seal." Motion denied.
