MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2020-1304. *State v. Burroughs.*

Marion App. No. 9-19-91, 2020-Ohio-4417. On appellant's motion for appointment of counsel. Motion granted. Office of the Ohio Public Defender appointed to represent appellant.

2021-0936. *State v. D-Bey.*

Cuyahoga App. No. 1091000. Sua sponte, pages 16 through 28 of appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction stricken for failure to comply with S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.02(B) (requiring that a memorandum "not exceed fifteen numbered pages, exclusive of the table of contents and the certificate of service").

2021-0943. *Erzurum v. Erzurum.*

Mahoning App. No. 20 MA 0012, 2021-Ohio-2014. On appellants' motion to refer the case to mediation. Motion denied as moot.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2018-0817. *Disciplinary Counsel v. Harmon.*

On application of respondent, Phillip Louis Harmon, Attorney Registration No. 0033371, last known business address in Westerville, Ohio, to terminate probation. Application granted.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

2021-0729. State ex rel. Jackintell v. Viland.

In Mandamus. On relator's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

MEDIATION MATTERS

The following case has been returned to the regular docket under S.Ct.Prac.R. 19.01.

2021-0908. State ex rel. Parcher v. Perry.

In Mandamus. Respondent shall file a response to the complaint within 21 days.

2019-0016. Ohio Veterans & Fraternal Charitable Coalition v. Yost.

Franklin App. No. 18AP-199, 2018-Ohio-4679. Appellants shall file either an application for dismissal or a merit brief in accordance with the Supreme Court Rules of Practice within 60 days. This case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or a merit brief is not filed within 60 days.

2021-0630. State ex rel. Heiland v. Basinski.

In Mandamus and Procedendo. Relator shall file either an application for dismissal or a notice of failure of settlement within 60 days. This case will be dismissed for want of prosecution if an application for dismissal or a notice of failure of settlement is not filed within 60 days.
