- 1. Amendments to the Appendix of Forms of the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure (Form 20) were adopted April 6, 2023, and are effective on July 1, 2023.
- 2. On April 6 and 18, 2023, amendments to the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure (Civ.R. 1, 1.1, 4.1, 4.6, 10, 26, 30, 33, 36, 37, 39, 43, 45, 53, 57, 65.1, 73, and 75 and Civil Form 20), the Ohio Rules of Criminal Procedure (Crim.R. 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 10, 12, 15, 19, 40, 43, and 46), the Ohio Rules of Evidence (Evid.R. 101, 601, 607, 609, and 616), the Ohio Rules of Juvenile Procedure (Juv.R. 1, 2, 7, 8, 18, 30, 34, 35, 40, and 41), and the Ohio Traffic Rules (Traf.R. 4) were approved. The amendments to the Ohio Traffic Rules are effective on July 1, 2023. The amendments to the Rules of Practice and Procedure were filed with the General Assembly and are effective on July 1, 2023, unless the General Assembly passes a concurrent resolution of disapproval before that date. The final versions of the amendments have been posted on the court's website.

Kennedy, C.J., and Fischer, DeWine, Donnelly, Stewart, and Deters, JJ., concurred in adopting the amendments and in approving the amendments for filing with the General Assembly.

Brunner, J., concurred in part and dissented in part and would not have approved the amendments to the Ohio Rules of Evidence for filing with the General Assembly.
